#### To be TRAINED, you must:

- Complete <u>YOUTH</u>
   <u>PROTECTION TRAINING</u>
   every two years
- Complete <u>HAZARDOUS</u>
   <u>WEATHER TRAINING</u>
   <u>every two years</u>
- Complete your appropriate level of <u>POSITION-SPECIFIC</u> <u>TRAINING</u> for your position. A new position-specific training also is required when you change leadership roles.

This training is to teach you the outdoor skills that a Scout needs to achieve the rank of First Class. It also makes you comfortable teaching these skills to Scouts, WEBELOS scouts or Crew members so that they may participate in the BSA Outdoor Program.

Scoutmasters and Assistants must complete this training along with Scoutmaster Position-Specific Training, Youth Protection Training, and Hazardous Weather Training to meet the "TRAINED" requirements for these positions.

Venturing Advisors and Associates, Troop, and Crew Committee Members, Interested Adults, and Parents are also invited to attend this training to learn these skills.

The knowledge to teach and pass along these outdoor skills are important for all Scout Leaders.
