To be TRAINED, you must:

- Complete <u>YOUTH</u>
 <u>PROTECTION TRAINING</u>
 every two years
- Complete <u>HAZARDOUS</u> <u>WEATHER TRAINING</u> every two years
- Complete your appropriate level of <u>POSITION-SPECIFIC</u> <u>TRAINING</u> for your position. A new position-specific training also is required when you change leadership roles.
