- When: October 24th-25th (In Person 7:30am Sat—1 pm Sun).
*****ALL SESSIONS ARE MANDATORY**
- Where: The session is taught in person (October 24th - 25th) at Camp Warren McConnell, see map on next page.
- Who: Adult leaders (18+ years old) and youth (14+ years and 1st class or above). Youth must be accompanied by an adult leader. **Please see the “Greater Yosemite Council High Adventure Team Code of Conduct” for clarification.**
- Cost: **\$45.00** (\$55.00 after Sat, Oct 3rd, 2026).
- Numbers: There must be at least 4 participants registered by October 3rd, 2026. Class size limited to 24 individuals.
- Includes: Saturday night Cracker Barrel and Sunday breakfast and lunch.
- Bring: Bring suitable clothing, footwear, and equipment for outdoor activities. Bring lunch and snacks for two days, and a dinner. Certificate of online training for youth protection/ Hazardous Weather.

Upon successful completion of the Leave No Trace Trainer Course, each participant will become a qualified **Leave No Trace Trainer**. Those who complete the course are equipped to:

- Understand, demonstrate, and teach minimum impact techniques;
- Lead outdoor ethics discussions and help others explore their own personal outdoor ethic; and,
- Conduct Leave No Trace Skills courses and Awareness Workshops.

Participants must complete all 16 hours of the training and show proof of completion of the BSA Youth Protection Training and Hazardous Weather Training to graduate from this course.

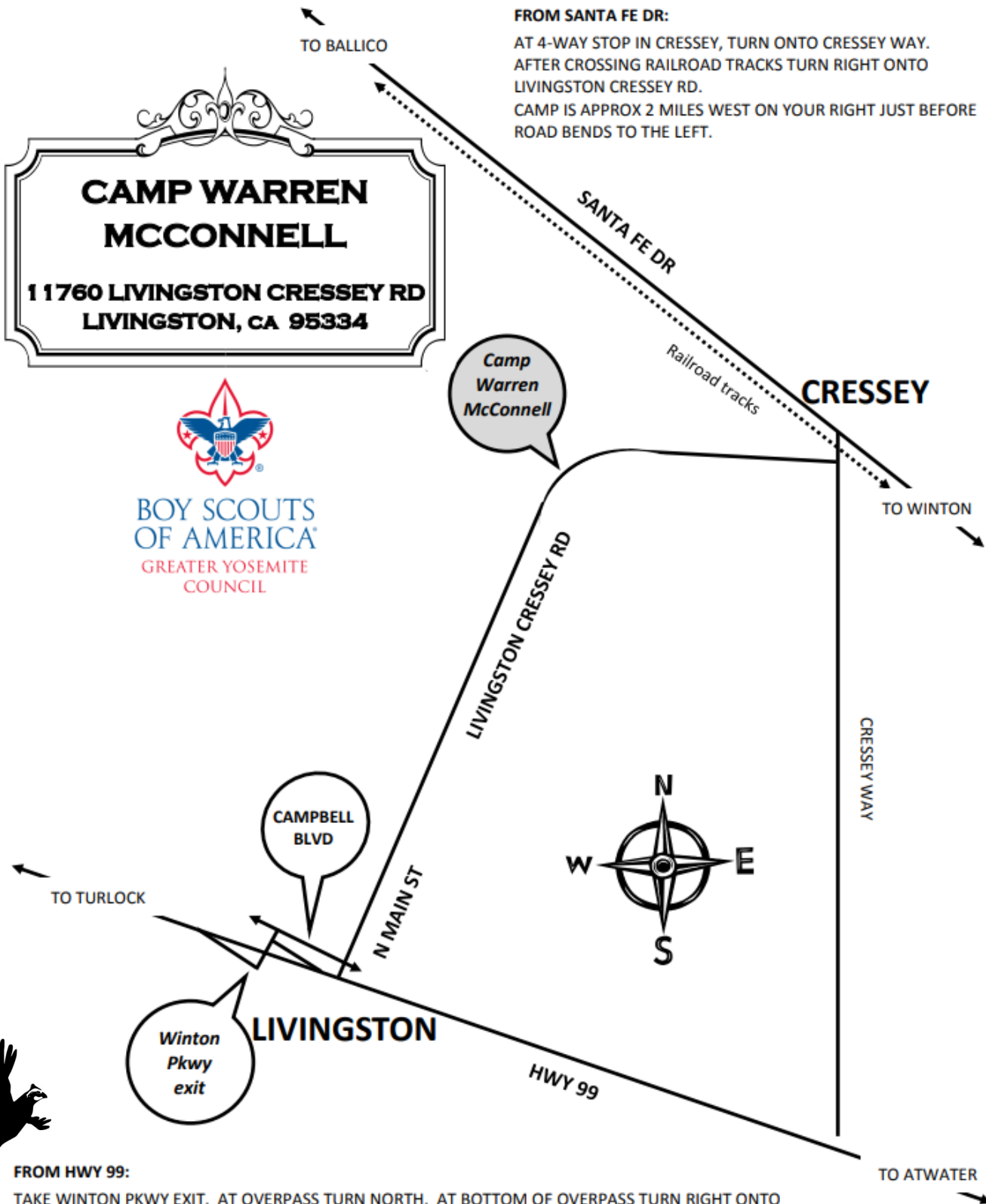

FROM SANTA FE DR:
AT 4-WAY STOP IN CRESSEY, TURN ONTO CRESSEY WAY.
AFTER CROSSING RAILROAD TRACKS TURN RIGHT ONTO
LIVINGSTON CRESSEY RD.
CAMP IS APPROX 2 MILES WEST ON YOUR RIGHT JUST BEFORE
ROAD BENDS TO THE LEFT.



FROM HWY 99:
TAKE WINTON PKWY EXIT. AT OVERPASS TURN NORTH. AT BOTTOM OF OVERPASS TURN RIGHT ONTO
CAMPBELL BLVD. AT 4-WAY STOP TURN LEFT ONTO N MAIN STREET. THIS WILL BECOME LIVINGSTON CRESSEY
RD JUST OUTSIDE OF TOWN.
CAMP IS APPROX. 2.5 MILES FROM 4-WAY INTERSECTION—LOOK FOR WHITE FENCE ON YOUR LEFT AS ROAD
BENDS TO THE RIGHT.



We are offering a dual track hybrid course in order to comply with changes from Leave No Trace.

Registered Scouters (age 18 and over) may take the Leave No Trace Level 1 Instructor (formerly Trainer) course leading to certification as a Level 1 Leave No Trace Instructor.

Registered Scouts (First Class and at least age 14) and Scouters may take the Leave No Trace Skills course (Certificate of Completion by Leave no Trace)

Level 1 Instructor certification will require 2 hours of online training prior to the weekend and a 10-15 minute presentation of outdoor training at Camp Herms to be determined at the online training.
