

Being Prepared for Your Eagle Board of Review

The Eagle Candidate will be called by the BSA Office to remind them of their scheduled time.

Arrive at the First Methodist Church at 200 W. Oak St., Lodi no later than 7PM (unless otherwise informed of a change).

Have your complete class A uniform, including Merit Badge Sash and Scout Handbook.

What to expect at the board of review:

- A. You will be called into the board of review.
- B. Your Scoutmaster, or a troop representative, should be there to introduce you to the board.
- C. Be prepared to look each board member in the eye and greet them with a proper handshake.
- D. The Board Chairman will ask you to lead in the Pledge of Allegiance.
- E. The Board Chairman will ask you to recite the Scout Law, Scout Oath, Motto and Slogan.
- F. The Board Chairman will ask you to discuss the Outdoor Code.
- G. Be prepared to discuss your Eagle Project, discuss how you showed Leadership.
- H. Be prepared to discuss what any of the Scout Laws mean to you.
- I. Be prepared to discuss what Scouting means to you.
- J. The Board will ask you questions and discuss many items with you.
- K. At the conclusion of the review, the Board will ask you to step out so that the Board can discuss your Board of Review.
- L. You will be called back in at the conclusion with your parent(s) and be informed of the Board's decision.

Letters of recommendation are NO longer turned over to the Scout per National guidelines. This is so that those providing the letters will give an honest assessment of the Scout and family.
