Webelos Den leaders should attend this training before conducting Webelos overnight camping with the boys and parents of the Den. In addition to covering basic camping skills, this training features planning campouts and finding resources. Other Cub Leaders are welcome to attend.



TAKE WINTON PKWY EXIT. AT OVERPASS TURN NORTH. AT BOTTOM OF OVERPASS TURN RIGHT ONTO CAMPBELL BLVD. AT 4-WAY STOP TURN LEFT ONTO N MAIN STREET. THIS WILL BECOME LIVINGSTON CRESSEY RD JUST OUTSIDE OF TOWN.
