## Training being offered:

◆ Trainer's EDGE (H96) Expires in 3 years.

The purpose of the Trainer's EDGE course is to provide and help develop the platform skills of a trainer. It is meant to supplement the practice offered through Wood Badge and NYLT staff development, with a focus on the participant, while raising the level of skill a trainer brings to the staff experience. It is also for any Trainer that would like to further elevate their skills.

#### Note:

This course is required for Wood Badge and NYLT staff prior to serving on staff.

Only practice can polish these skills, but this course is intended to "Train the Trainer" on behaviors and resources while offering hands-on experience in methods and media.

**Precourse Preparation:** Please prepare a 10-12 minute presentation on a topic from any BSA material. Your presentation should allow you to demonstrate the skills of a trainer. You will receive constructive feedback on your presentation from the other participants.
