- Complete HAZARDOUS WEATHER TRAINING
every two years
- Complete your appropriate level of POSITION-SPECIFIC TRAINING for your position. A new position-specific training also is required when you change leadership roles.

Scoutmasters and Assistants must complete this training along with Scoutmaster Position-Specific Training, Safeguarding Youth Training, and Hazardous Weather Training to meet the "TRAINED" requirements for these positions.

Venturing Advisors and Associates, Troop, and Committee Members, Interested Adults, and Parents are also invited to attend this training to learn these skills.

The knowledge to teach and pass along these outdoor skills are important for all Scout Leaders.
